NICE Guidance (Maternal & Child Nutrition):

"Ensure health professionals who prescribe drugs to a breastfeeding mother consult supplementary sources (for example, the Drugs & Lactation Database [LactMed]) or seek guidance from the UK Drugs in Lactation Advisory Service"

"the 'British national formulary' should only be used as a guide as it does not contain quantitative data on which to base individual decisions"

"Health professionals should recognise that there may be adverse health consequences for both mother and baby if the mother does not breastfeed. They should also recognise that it may not be easy for the mother to stop breastfeeding abruptly - and that it is difficult to reverse"
